# PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of the State of Tennessee stand fully committed to quality afterschool programs and opportunities because they provide safe, challenging, and engaging learning experiences that help children develop social, emotional, physical and academic skills; and

**WHEREAS**, afterschool programs also support working families by ensuring their children are safe and productive after the regular school day ends; build stronger communities by involving students, parents, business leaders and adult volunteers in the lives of young people, thereby promoting positive relationships among youth, families and adults; and

**WHEREAS**, afterschool programs engage families, schools and community partners in advancing the welfare of our children; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Tennessee has provided significant leadership in the area of community involvement in the education and well-being of our youth, grounded in the principle that quality afterschool programs are key to helping our children become successful adults; and

**WHEREAS**, "Lights On Afterschool", the national celebration of afterschool programs held this year on October 22, 2015, promotes the importance of quality afterschool programs in the lives of children, families and communities; and

**WHEREAS**, the United Ways of Tennessee has established the Tennessee Afterschool Network with a mission to support children, youth, families and communities by advocating and building capacity with a unified voice for sustainable investments in safe, healthy and nurturing afterschool experiences; and

**WHEREAS**, 19.4 million families report that they would enroll their child in an afterschool program if one were available; and

**WHEREAS**, these expanded learning opportunities help close the achievement gap and prepare young people to compete in the global economy;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim October 22, 2015 as
