WHEREAS, all shelter pets need a loving owner and a safe, happy home; and

WHEREAS, there are many dogs and cats housed in Tennessee animal shelters that are available and awaiting the opportunity to be an affectionate companion; and

WHEREAS, it is also vital to raise awareness of the need for proper spay & neuter programs as well as the importance of providing good veterinary care for our pets; and

WHEREAS, Sweetwater Valley Dog Rescue joins with shelters across the state to raise awareness of these important concerns;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Governor Bill Haslam of the Great State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim the month of March, 2016 as

Adopt A Shelter Pet Month

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
